

Girls, boys win three-team meet

FOSTORIA — Eastwood's girls and boys both won a three-team meet Tuesday at Memorial Stadium.

The Eagle girls won 15 of the 17 events and totaled 119 points to finish ahead of Otsego with 35 points and Fostoria with 17.

"They came out and competed very well, and we're excited to see what Friday brings," Eagle coach Nikki Sabo said, referring to the Eastwood Relays.

Katelyn Meyer won two events for Eastwood, finishing first in the 100 hurdles in 15.99 and the 300 hurdles in 50.53. The junior was given the day off in the high jump where she had broken the school record in her last two meets. She also didn't compete in the long jump.
